On Tuesday , December 1, 2016, the Chambersburg Cold Weather Drop in shelter will begin the 13th year of service to the community, operating entirely as a faith- based effort, receiving no borough, county, or state funds.

The procedures that operated successfully last season will remain in effect with a few minor changes for this season. The shelter will accommodate 14 man and 6 women from 7pm to 7am daily, seven days a week. Since there are other shelters in the area that accept children, this shelter will adhere to its policy of not accepting children. House rules will be made known to guests as they arrive.

Volunteers will be required again for the evening shift – 7pm to 12pm. Three volunteers are requested. To volunteer for the evening shift send a g-mail to craignewcomermmi@gmail.com Local organizations and church groups will be asked to bring in the hot meal each evening at 7pm for the guests. Not content with merely providing just a shelter and a warm bed against the cold weather, the staff will counsel guests and aid them in finding more permanent housing. The staff may direct them to service agencies that will address their problems.

The Board of Directors and the multitude of volunteers who have already served are grateful for the broad support from the community. They sincerely hope efforts will continue again in the 2016/2017 season for this needed service to the community.
